This is to acknowledge receipt of your email and to say that I'm assigning Adam Weiser to look at these traffic and pedestrian operation conditions again. We have used in-roadway warning lights at a crosswalk on Shipley Road in New Castle County at the Northeast Greenway Pedestrian Crossing. This was a demonstration project that we were not satisfied with the performance and the operation of the light system. They are a constant maintenance headache and they are susceptible to damage by snow plows. They seem to offer no more warning than the standard signs for a pedestrian crossing.
