Did you know?

With naturally sandy soil and a high water table, a significant **86%** of our town sits within the flood plain. This means that the water level goes up quickly when it rains. However, by implementing an effective proper drainage system, homeowners can ensure that it also drains very quickly. Refer to the complete best practices listing on the town website at:

Do your part to protect Bethany Beach and surrounding wetlands from stormwater intrusion, flooding, and runoff pollution!

- Install booted gutter systems on your home, leading to natural drainage areas/landscaping.
- **Clean** drainage swales / promote positive drainage.
- Install pervious driveways in accordance with town ordinances.
- Maintain maximum natural areas, trees, and pervious ground covering in accordance with town ordinances.
- Use **porous landscape fabric**, NOT impervious fabric.



- Promote natural street drainage. Be sure not to block the flow to swales and drainage structures.
- Reduce pollution of wetlands and waterways by using organic fertilizers and weed killers in lieu of chemicals (Round UP).
- Install all utility equipment at least 18" above base flood elevation.
- Install lower-level water relief louvers or flood vents.
- Install French drains and/or sumps with pumps to natural drainage areas as needed.
